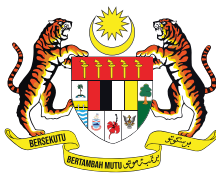

Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Climate Resilience

The Kuala Lumpur Sustainability Summit also gives rise to the Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Climate Resilience, a national call to action that builds upon the Kuala Lumpur Sustainable Declaration on Localising the ASEAN Community Vision 2045, adopted through the Meeting of Governors and Mayors of ASEAN Capitals (MGMAC) Communiqué 2025.

The Declaration extends that regional commitment into Malaysia's national context, uniting government, business, and communities in a shared effort to strengthen climate adaptation, enhance resilience, and accelerate practical action on the ground. It invites all sectors to align with this vision, reaffirming that Malaysia's path to sustainability must be collective, inclusive, and enduring.

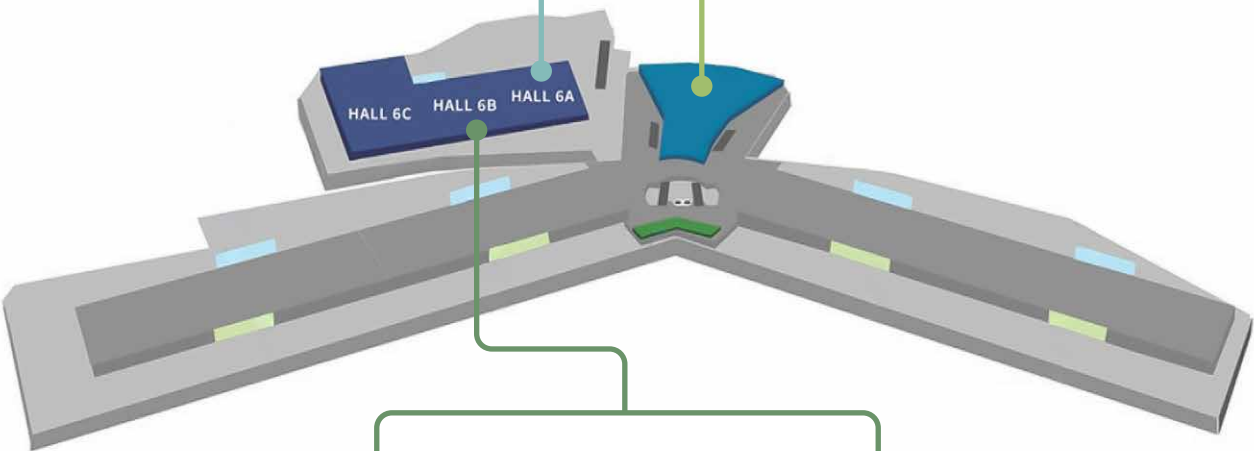
